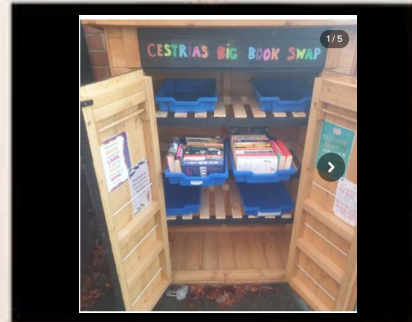


Cestria's Big Book Swap

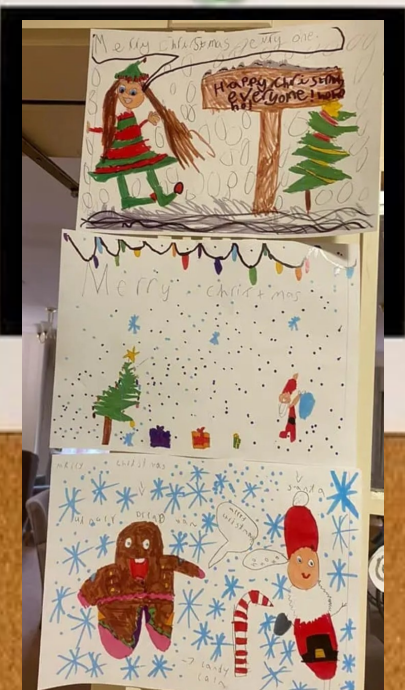

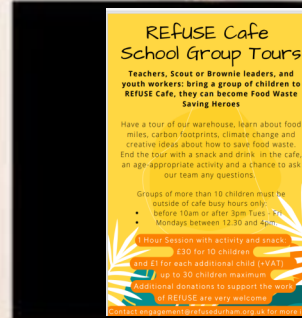
