
Invisible Disabilities




World Mental Health Day

Year 4 in DT, we have made torches out of plastic bottles, made a working switch and put together a circuit to make it light up! Well done everyone!




Amazing Art!

Roman Recruits


The children have very much enjoyed finding out about the Romans. They have designed and made their own shields!

Year 3 as a follow up to invisible disabilities week last week, created a kindness sunflower filled with different acts of kindness you could do to help someone with a disability.







Voices and Choices


